- IEDD experience within the past 8 years with a minimum of 3 years cumulative experience in EOD/IEDD. CVs must contain a very detailed chronological account of relevant work, responsibilities and tasks conducted, including in which capacity, in which country and with what organization to demonstrate suitability to the position.
- Fluent in English, written and spoken, proven either through native speaker or at least 3 years working in English speaking environments.
- Must be medically fit, mentally and physically robust to meet the challenge of operating in austere environments, harsh conditions and extremes of temperature.
